Bachelors of Business Administration (BBA) - Corporate Accounting

General Requirements

Students may transfer up to 75 semester credits toward the Cleary University BBA degree. Of these, a maximum of 15 may be Prior Learning acquired through non-college learning. Prior Learning can be documented through CLEP, Military Training, Cleary Proficiency Exam, Training/Certification, or Proficiency Portfolio Appeal. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for admission. All courses successfully completed at WCC that would apply toward a WCC degree will be accepted for transfer. Entry skills assessment and course placement are required in writing, mathematics, and computing.

Required Courses

These courses are required prerequisites for entry into the Cleary University BBA Residency program and should be completed at WCC or at Cleary.
