## FEDERAL WORK STUDY PROGRAM

- The Federal Work Study Program (FWS) is a financial aid-based program designed to assist students in finding employment on college campuses
- Students must be awarded Federal Work Study funds through the Financial Aid Office to take part in the FWS
- First-time awarded students must attend a mandatory New Work Study Employee Orientation with WCC's Career Transitions team
- Returning Work Study employees will need to pick up a Work Study Authorization form from the WCC Career Transitions office (SC 112)
- Work Study employees can work a maximum of 19 hours per week through the course of the semester
- FWS jobs are not available for students on "Non-Immigrant" Visas (i.e. F-1visa)
